

Class and Division Descriptions

Leadline Division: Open to riders 8 years of age and under. To individually trot. Leader on foot must be 14 years of age or older.

1. Leadline Equitation
2. Leadline Pleasure
3. Leadline Ground Poles

Therapeutic Program Leadline: Open to any rider in a therapeutic riding program

4. TP Leadline Equitation
5. TP Leadline Ground Poles

Beginner Walk Trot Division: Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be shown at walk and trot only. Riders may not cross enter into any other division. Fences not to exceed 18". Class will be split if there are enough entrants.

6. Beginner Walk Trot Equitation
7. Beginner Walk Trot Pleasure
8. Beginner Walk Trot Crossrails 18"

Walk Trot Equitation Division: Open to riders 11 years of age and over. To be shown at walk and trot only. Fences not to exceed 18". May cross enter into Walk-Trot Hunter and First Look.

9. Walk Trot Equitation on the Flat
10. Walk Trot Equitation (A) 18"
11. Walk Trot Equitation (B) 18"

Walk Trot Hunter Division: Open to riders 11 years of age and over. To be shown at walk and trot only. Fences not to exceed 18". May cross enter into Walk-Trot Eq. division. and First Look.

12. Walk Trot Hunter Under Saddle
13. Walk Trot Hunter (A) 18"
14. Walk Trot Hunter (B) 18"

First Look Division: Open to horses or ponies in their first year of showing. To be shown at walk and trot only, may trot or canter crossrails. Horses may not be cross entered in classes requiring canter or having fences exceeding 18". Simple changes are permissible

15. First Look Hunter
16. First Look Pleasure
17. First Look Crossrails 18"

Short Stirrup Equitation Division: Open to riders 13 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter. Fences not to exceed 18". Riders may not cross enter in classes with fences exceeding 18". May cross enter into Short Stirrup Hunter and Pleasure Horse Division only.

18. Short Stirrup Equitation (A) 18"
19. Short Stirrup Equitation (B) 18"
20. Short Stirrup Equitation on the Flat
21. **Short Stirrup Medal:** To be shown over a course of fences, Tests may be required throughout the course. Ten points to qualify for year end finals to be held at October show.

Short Stirrup Hunter Division: Open to riders 13 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter. Fences not to exceed 18". Riders may not cross enter in classes with fences exceeding 18". May cross enter into Short Stirrup Eq. and Pleasure Horse Division only.

22. Short Stirrup (A) 18"
23. Short Stirrup (B) 18"
24. Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

Walk-Trot-Canter Division: Open to all horse and riders (riders in two years of showing) who are walk-trot-canter. Choice of poles or crossrails Riders may cross enter into the Pleasure Horse Division.

25. WTC equitation

26. WTC pleasure
27. WTC over poles (judged on equitation)

Pleasure Horse Division: Open to all horse and rider combinations. To be shown at walk, trot and canter.

28. Open Pleasure
29. Hunter Pleasure
30. Bridle Path Hack (may be asked to hand gallop)

Unjudged 2' Warm-up (Lunch Break not before 11AM)

School Horse Division: Open to all horses and ponies used in a regular school program. Riders of all ages. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'. Simple changes are permissible.

31. School Horse (A) 2'
32. School Horse (B) 2'
33. School Horse Under Saddle

Maiden Equitation: Open to all horse and rider (under 18) combinations. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'.

34. Maiden Equitation 2'
35. Maiden Equitation on the Flat

Low Hunter Division: Open to all horse and rider combinations. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'

36. Low Hunter (A) 2'
37. Low Hunter (B) 2'
38. Low Hunter on the Flat

Novice Equitation: Open to all horse and rider combinations regardless of rider's age. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

39. Novice Equitation 2'3"
40. Novice Equitation on the Flat

Schooling Hunter Division: Open to all horse and rider combinations. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'3"

41. Schooling Hunter (A) 2'3"
42. Schooling Hunter (B) 2'3"
43. Schooling Hunter Under Saddle
44. **August Farm Mini Medal:** To be shown over a course of fences, not to exceed 2'3". Tests may be required throughout the course. Ten points to qualify for year end finals to be held at October show.

Special Hunter Division: Open to all horse and rider combinations. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Fences to be either 2'6" or 3', rider to choose height.

45. Special Hunter (A) 2'6" or 3'
46. Special Hunter (B) 2'6" or 3'
47. Special Hunter Under Saddle
48. **August Farm Open Medal:** Open to all horse and rider combinations. To be shown over a course of fences, 2'9"-3'0". Tests may be required throughout the course. Ten points to qualify for year end finals to be held at October show.

Rules and Regulations

1. Approved headgear to be worn at all times while mounted on a horse or pony
2. Judge's decision is final
3. We reserve the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes as necessary
4. All entries must show proof of negative coggins test within one year.
5. All pre-entries must be accompanied by a check. Pre-entries are due the Thursday prior to the show.
6. All dogs must be leashed
7. Refunds only with a veterinary and/or physician's certificate or note
8. To be eligible for the Trainer's Award, trainer must sign in at each show.
